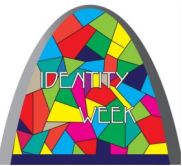

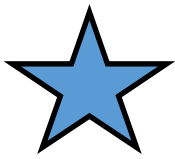
IDENTITY SUMMER 2021!
