

### Choose Your Mission Event

Welcome Back! We are eager to serve Jesus with you this summer. Our approach has changed to accommodate the restrictions due to Covid. There will be several offerings of activities with varied times, places, and settings. There will also be a "safety scale" noting the anticipated social interaction level at each event. Please view your options and choose the best that suits your needs. If space is available to do more than one mission event with us, you may sign up after May 25 for additional events. Read the options, then make your first selection. There are limited spots in each event and they will be filled on a first come, first served basis.

1. Children's Ministry at Christian Friends of New Americans (CFNA)
  - a. Do you enjoy teaching and hanging out with younger children? Then this may be your activity! We will be conducting a mini-VBS for the children of CFNA, complete with singing, drama, crafts, snacks, games and more! **This event will take place with a planning meeting on Sunday, June 6, 2021, from 5:00-7:30 pm. (Dinner Provided). Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday, June 7 – 9, 2021, you may be dropped off at 8:30 a.m. and be picked up at 1:00 p.m.** You will be enjoying lunch daily with the children. \*\* Masks are required at all times for this event. We will be indoors with all windows open and practicing appropriate occupancy standards, however you are working with children - so proximity will not always be 6 feet!
  
2. Soccer at Hodiamont
  - a. Start off in the Hodiamont housing development where we will be meeting New American neighbors and sharing the love of Jesus through a game of soccer. **This event will be from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 5, 2021.** Drop off and pick up will be at a park nearby - location to be announced. Lunch will be provided. \*\* Masks are required at all times but are optional if actively playing soccer. We will be outdoors at all times, however you are working with children and playing soccer - so proximity will not always be 6 feet!
  
3. Signs of Hope
  - a. Signs of Hope will be an opportunity to spread God's love with Holly Hills community and people driving through Holly Hills on **Wednesday, June 16, 2021. This event is scheduled for 1:00 - 5:30 p.m.**, starting with a meet and greet at Epiphany, cleaning of Carondelet Park, and waving signs of hope on the boulevard! Snacks will be provided. \*\* Masks are required, also we will be outdoors at all times and will practice social distancing.
  
4. Recess with Woerner
  - a. Recess is everyone's favorite subject - and this summer it will be even better at the Woerner Elementary summer school program! Help teach children how to play pickleball, kickball, and gaga ball during their recess time. **On Monday and Tuesday, June 14 and 15, 2021, we will meet up at Epiphany at 9:30 a.m. to begin our day with a devotion. Then we will head over to Woerner to begin teaching the kids these games and play with them. After the time with the students, we will come back to Epiphany for lunch on the lawn and time in the Word together. Parent pick up at 1:30 p.m.** \*\* Masks will be required at all times. We will be outdoors at all times. Social distancing will be observed at the volunteer's discretion while coaching.
