Missouri District News - Storm Disaster Relief: The storms of December 10th have left many Missourians in need of comfort. A member of Christ Lutheran in Augusta lost her life, and the family home was destroyed. Families from St. Paul Lutheran in New Melle have incurred residential damages. The sanctuary roof of St. Trinity Lutheran in St. Louis was damaged beyond repair and requires replacing. The Missouri District will continue to support affected congregations and families in the days ahead—sharing the “peace that passes all understanding” to ease their burden, as well as our financial resources.
